TERMS & CONDITIONS

Registrations for additional services are subject to the specific registration period for each service. Applications received after the published deadline may not be accepted, and places are allocated on a first-come, first-served basis where capacity is limited.

Where applicable, a one-week trial period applies at the start of the service. After this period, changes or withdrawals due to preference are not permitted, and the full fees remain payable. Any concerns should be raised with the administration (admin@britishschoolgeneva.ch), who will work with the relevant staff to resolve issues where possible.

Cancellations are only permitted in accordance with the cancellation policy for the relevant service. Where termly cancellation deadlines apply, these must be met in order to avoid charges for the following term. Late cancellations will be charged in full.

Refunds are only considered in cases of illness lasting more than two consecutive weeks and must be supported by a medical certificate. Refund requests must be submitted during the week the student returns to school. Short absences are not eligible for a refund.

If the school cancels a session or service, a replacement session will be arranged where possible, or a credit will be issued. No refunds or credits will be provided for student absences.

Students are expected to attend regularly, where applicable, and behave appropriately. Persistent misconduct may result in removal from the service without refund.

Invoices are issued in accordance with the billing schedule for each service and must be paid within 30 days. Non-payment may result in suspension or withdrawal from current and future additional services.

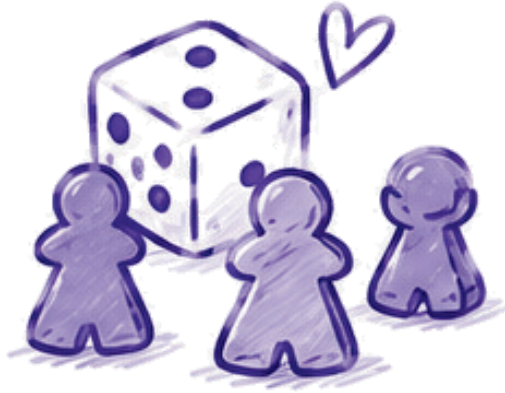

AFTER SCHOOL CARE

Our After School Care programme provides a safe, welcoming, and supervised environment for Primary students at the end of the school day.

Running every Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday, the service is available from 15:45 to 18:00 or from 16:45 to 18:00 following an ECA, offering flexibility for families while ensuring children are cared for in a nurturing setting.

Students can enjoy a variety of age-appropriate activities, including arts and crafts, games, reading, outdoor play, and quiet relaxation time. The programme encourages social interaction, creativity, and independence while allowing children to unwind after a busy day at school.

Led by caring and experienced staff, After School Care provides a comfortable and supportive atmosphere where students can have fun, make friends, and feel at home until collection time.

An afternoon snack is included as part of the provision.

SUPERVISED STUDY

Our Supervised Study programme provides KS4 students with a structured and productive environment to support their GCSE studies.

Running every Tuesday and Thursday after school, the sessions offer dedicated time for independent revision, homework completion, coursework, and exam preparation in a quiet and focused setting.

Students are encouraged to develop effective study habits, improve their organisational skills, and take responsibility for their learning.

While this is not a tutoring session, staff are present to supervise, support good study practices, and help maintain a positive learning atmosphere.

Supervised Study is an excellent opportunity for students to stay on top of their academic commitments, prepare confidently for assessments, and make the most of their study time after school.

CANTEEN

Our school canteen is available to all students across the school and operates every weekday, Monday to Friday, providing a healthy, balanced, and varied selection of meals each day.

The canteen is an important part of school life, providing a welcoming space where students can enjoy their lunch, socialise with friends, and recharge for the afternoon.

Yes. Primary students attending an ECA can continue into After-School Care until 18:00.

Yes. Occasional lunches are available for families who do not require a regular meal plan at 20 CHF per meal.
